

Play Dough Constellations



Activity:

Learn about constellations either from a library book or the internet. You can then help your child make their own constellations by placing either paper or glow in the dark stars onto the playdough.

Supplies:

- -Blue or black play dough or black construction paper
- -Plastic glow in the dark stars or cut out stars from white paper
- -Library book about constellations or device with internet access to learn about constellations

Instructions:

- 1. Read about constellations either in a book or online
- 2. Roll out the play dough to make the sky in outer space (if you have play dough)
- 3. Choose a constellation and re-create it by placing the stars onto the play dough or black construction paper
- 4. Ask your child how many stars are in their constellation
- 5. Repeat with a different constellation
